ISIC CARD

JVLMA will issue your ISIC student card at the beginning of your exchange studies. The ISIC card entitles you to use the Academy library, collection of recordings, as well as grants discounts on theatre and concert tickets. Visit https://www.isic.lv/en or use the mobile application for more information on current discounts and offers.

Your ISIC card means free entrance for performances in the National Opera and Ballet Theatre with the exception of premieres and guest performances. You will have no assigned seat, but usually it is possible to find some free seat.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT & STUDENT TICKET

Trams, trolleybuses and buses provide public transportation in the city. Information of public transport routes and timetables you will find on *Rīgas Satiksme* website: https://www.rigassatiksme.lv/en/for-rigaguests/

You can apply for student discounts on monthly public transport ticket. The ticket is valid for all types of city public transport and it costs 12 €.

Should you wish to purchase a student ticket, please visit the International Office (Room 112) first to receive a Certificate that confirms your status as a JVLMA student. You should submit the Certificate and present your personal identification document at the customer centre of *Rīgas Satiksme* afterwards.

ROOMS for PRACTICING

JVLMA has online room reservation and event management system **ASIMUT** that is used in the most prestigious music academies in Europe. The ASIMUT system can be accessed using the direct link: https://jvlma.asimut.net.

Your user name and password for ASIMUT will be sent to your e-mail address before beginning of the studies. In case of some problems, please contact the International Office or IT department: it@jvlma.lv

Latvian is set as the default language of ASIMUT. Under *Manas preferences -> Valoda* you will find an option to change the language. Please confirm your changes by clicking *Saglabāt*.

All rooms in the system are divided in groups according to the floors – Basement *(Pagrabstāvs)*, Floor 1, Floor 2, Floor 3 (I), Floor 3 (II), Floor 5. Clicking on the group you will open all rooms on the respective floor.

The rooms that are open for reservation are displayed as white spaces. After making reservation click *Save* and your reservation will appear on your personal planner.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO CANCEL RESERVATION IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO USE IT, otherwise you will lose your quota. You can make reservations <u>3 days in advance for max. 4 hours</u>.

The reservation should be reconfirmed before it starts. Don't be late – after 15 minutes your reservation will be automatically deleted. Reconfirmation can be done in your ASIMUT account by clicking *Reconfirm* on the booked time. This option is available only via WiFi network of JVLMA.

The employee at the key desk will issue the key for the room. Please remember to return the key as soon as you finish practicing.



Before you left the room, please close the piano lid, shut the windows, switch off all electrical equipment and make sure that no personal belongings are left in the room. Both JVLMA buildings are architectural monuments; please be very gentle with them.

OPENING HOURS OF THE ACADEMY

Keys of classrooms will be issued no later than 30 min. before the closing time and they should be returned 10 min. before the closing time.

CLOAKROOM

It is advisable and safe to leave your coats and jackets in the cloakroom. Personal belongings should be kept in the lockers that are located in the cloakroom. **Renting a locker** costs € 1 a month; please ask Vita if you are interested in this option.

INSTRUMENT STORAGE

There is a common lockable storage space for instruments in the cloakroom. No books, scores, clothes and other belongings are allowed there - instruments only! Please ask Vita if you are interested in this option.

INTERNET ACCESS

The Wi-Fi connection is available in both Academy's buildings.

Access to the network *eduroam* (Education Roaming) is available with the same *eduroam* credentials you are using at your home university.

Other Wi-Fi networks are password-protected; the International Office will provide you with the access credentials.

Access to computers (including music notation program *Sibelius*) and Internet is available in Room 507 and in the book library (Room 106).

SWIMMING POOL

LIBRARY

JVLMA library is the oldest music and related literature repository in Latvia, safekeeping rare manuscripts, scores, books, sound and video recordings, and periodicals. Library stock holds approximately 92000 scores and 4500 books; special funds consist of research works by academic staff and students of former Latvian State Conservatoire and JVLMA. Musical scores by Latvian musicians, manuscripts, photographs and historical materials are also available.

There is a free of charge information database in the reading room: encyclopaedias, dictionaries and periodicals. Reading room provides excellent environment for studies and information gathering as well as free Internet access.

Main rules:

- During your first visit, the librarian will assign you a User ID number, which allows using the JVLMA library online catalogue and following the return deadlines.
- In case of overdue library books/scores/materials, the fine is charged for each day and each borrowed item.

Books and scores:

- The maximum borrowing time is 1 semester, the minimum 1 day, depending on the actual book/score.
- It is not possible to take home materials from archive and the single-copy items.
- Twice a year (in December and June) all borrowed materials must be re-registered by presenting them at the library.

Audio-visual recordings:

• It is possible to take sound recordings home (CD, DVD, except vinyl) for 2 days maximum.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Immediately inform the key desk attendant or your fellow students in case of any extraordinary situation in the Academy.
